### **Concept Question**

Are changes in national life and culture good?

# What I will learn (sticky knowledge)

I can talk about the Christmas story and explain why Jesus was good news for Christians.

I can name the figures in the Nativity: Mary, Joseph, Jesus, angels, shepherds, wise men.

I can sequence the events of the Christmas story.

I can discuss the importance of gifts in the Christmas story, and how Christians recognise the gift of Jesus.

## What I should already know (EYFS)

Explain why Christians say Jesus is special.

Develop curiosity as to why Christians do nativity at Christmas.

Explain why Christians give and receive presents at Christmas.

Encounter religion and world views through stories, special books, places, objects and events.



#### What I will learn next (Y2)

Explain why Christians might choose to follow Jesus.

Recall key teachings Christians believe about God found in the 'lost' parables, the parable of the Good Samaritan and other parables studied.

Describe key important things Christians believe about Jesus and refer to the Easter story, life and teachings of Jesus.

Evaluate key teachings studied from the Bible and explain why they may be important to Christians.
