Attendance Matters!

Good attendance is really important to your child's education so that they can achieve their best.

As you are aware school works hard to improve attendance rates.

For any child who's attendance falls below 96%, parents will receive a letter and if attendance continues to fall will be invited in for a meeting to discuss their child's attendance and a plan put in place to support their attendance.

Parents can help by:

1. Phoning school on your child's first day of absence and only allow days off for genuine illness.
2. Ensuring your child attends on time every day.
3. Wherever possible, arranging medical appointments outside school hours. Make sure your child attends just before and after medical appointments if they have to be in school time.
4. Knowing your child's attendance figure and talking to them about it.
5. Taking holidays in holiday times.
