




Parent Survey December 2021

84 responses


Question 1:



All parents bar one, who responded to the survey, feel their child is happy at school. One respondent answered (Strongly disagree) saying that their child was struggling with the transition from Year 4 to Year 5. This has been followed up individually and the parent has confirmed that their child is much happier in school now since returning after Christmas.


Actions – SLT will consider what's in place to support our current Year 4 cohort transitioning to Year 5 for this academic year. Our trainee Mental Health Practitioner has some work planned for the Summer term already with this cohort.

Question 2:



All bar one parent, who responded to the survey, feel their child is safe at school. One respondent answered (Disagree). This has been followed up individually and the parent has confirmed that their child now feels safe. No recommended actions.


Question 3:



All parents, except 4 who responded to the survey, feel the school makes sure its pupils are well behaved. Three respondents answered (Don't know) with no comment and the fourth did however comment saying 'very good school, my daughter likes all her teachers and is doing well'. These four responses have been followed up individually with Parents. 3 parents confirmed that they put (Don't Know) as they just weren't sure and one said that they didn't know what the school did to make sure the pupils behaved well.

Actions – SLT will ensure parents are signposted to the Behaviour policy on the website so are clearly aware of what the school has in place to ensure its pupils are well behaved.

Question 4:




27 parents, who responded to the survey, feel their child has been bullied and the school has dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively. 49 parents answered (Don't know), 4 answered (Disagree), 2

responded with (Don't know/Disagree) and 2 parents responded (Strongly disagree), but one said 'Overall this is a great school and my child is thriving here.' This has been followed up with many parents saying it was due to them not knowing if their child had been bullied or not and didn't want to put a negative comment.

Action – SLT to signpost parents to the Anti-bullying policy so they are clearly aware of how the school would deal with any bullying if it occurred.

Question 5:




74 parents, who responded to the survey, feel the school makes them aware of what their child is learning during the year. One respondent answered (Agree / Disagree) in Nursery, but commented 'All the staff in the pre-school are amazing. My child never wants to come home and wants to be there 7 days a week'. 6 responded (Disagree). One respondent answered (Strongly Disagree), but commented 'I have no issues with the school and my children have always been happy here'. Three respondents answered (Don't know). All have been followed up and no further action needed.

The Y5/6 Meet and Greet didn't take place due to covid restrictions where parents are usually informed of what their child will be learning throughout the year; this therefore has had an impact on the responses to this question when speaking to parents.


Actions – Parents to be signposted to the curriculum area on the website where all the information on their child's learning is uploaded.

71 parents, who responded to the survey, agree that when they have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly. 10 responded with (Don't know). However, one of these respondents commented 'Really happy with the school', and another commented with 'I feel for my child the school has done amazingly well and that she is doing very well and a third responded with 'Willow Wood is an excellent school. I moved my children from another school and have never regretted it'. 3 answered (Disagree). These have been followed up individually. No further action required.


Question 7:

Question 8:



64 parents responded with (Don't Know).


Actions – SENCO/ AHT to follow this up with a further survey for parents of pupils with SEND.

Question 9:





Question 10:





Question 12:




74 parents, who responded to the survey, feel the school supports their child’s wider personal development. 4 responded (Disagree). One was regarding their child’s transition from Y4 to 5 mentioned previously, another however commented ‘I have no issues with the school and my children have always been happy here’. The other respondents initially commented on ways they felt the school hadn’t initially supported their child’s wider personal development, but these had all now been resolved. No further action required.

6 responded (Don’t Know) – These have been followed up.


Actions – SLT to highlight all of the activities the school offers to support their child’s wider personal development.

One respondent answered (Strongly disagree) saying that their child was struggling with the transition from Year 4 to Year 5.
