I can observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.


What I should already know (EYFS)

Stem

Key	Definition
Vocabulary	
deciduous	tree or bush that loses its leaves inthe autumn every year.
evergreen	a tree or bush which has green leaves all the year round.
season	the 4 parts a year can be put into, each has their own typical weather conditions.
bulb	is a root shaped like an onion that grows into a flower or plant.
trunk	of a tree is the large main stem from which the branches grow.
petal	are the thin coloured or white parts which together form the flower.
stem	the thin, upright part on which the flowers and leaves grow.
bark	the tough material that covers the outside of a tree.
