### What I will learn?

#### Our Enquiry Steps:

- What makes a book special?
- What sorts of different books are in the Bible?
- What words of wisdom are in the Bible?
- What could the story of David and Goliath teach a Christian?
- How does the story of the stilling of the storm help Christians?
- What prayers are there in the Bible and why do Christians pray?

#### RE Skills to develop:

- I can retell a religious story using prompts and know that it is from a sacred text and is special to some people.
- I can recognise some religious symbols and words.
- I ask questions about belonging, meaning and truth and can express my own ideas and opinions in response.

#### Our End Points:

- Emerging:** Child recognises that the Bible is a special book for Christians and how it has lots of different parts.
- Expected:** Child will refer to the Bible as being a sacred book for Christians and teaches them how to lead their lives. Can retell a story from the Bible. Knows that the Bible has two parts called Testaments.
- Exceeding:** Can explain some words of wisdom which can be found in the Bible. Shows interest in other sacred texts.

### Key Vocabulary

5 Fingers	Christianity, Christian, Bible, Hebrew, Aramaic, Greek, Church
Jesus	Christians believe that Jesus is God's son, part of the trinity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
Sacred Text	The term used for when a book is special for people who follow a religion. May contain words that originate from God.
Bible	The sacred text for Christians is called the Bible. It is the best selling book of all time. It teaches Christians about God. Some of it is important to other religions.
Testaments	The Bible is split into two parts called testaments. The old and new testaments.
Gospels	The first four books in the New Testament are called the Gospels, written by four disciples: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
Wisdom	The words in sacred texts which help a believer to make the right decision using knowledge and experience.
Prayer	Words which are said in the mind or out loud as a way of communicating with God for believers.
Belief	When someone feels that something is certain, exists or is true but to others it may not be proven.
Respect	A positive feeling shown towards somebody or something important.
Special	Someone or something different from normal, more important than other things or people.
