What I should already know

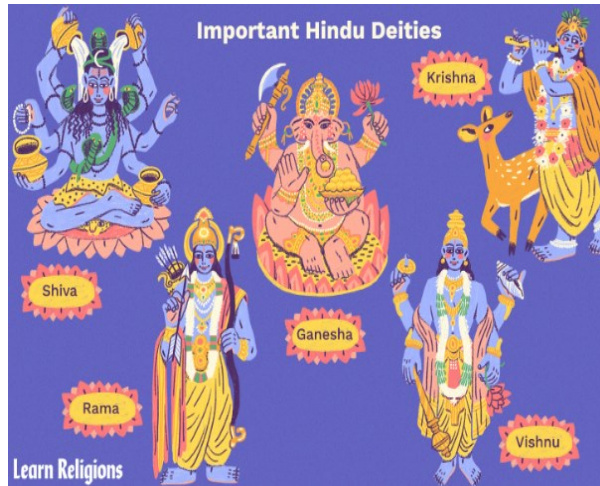
- I know that there are different religions in the world.

Mandir	A Hindu temple.
Puja	A prayer, service ritual done by Hindus.
Rama	Seventh Avatar of Vishnu in Hinduism. He was a king of ancient India.
Sita	In Hinduism Sita is the daughter of Janaka and wife of Rama.
Shiva	He is know as the destroyer God.
Vedas	Four collections of hymns, songs and poems.
Vishnu	One of the 3 main gods of Hinduism.
