Dear Parents and Carers,










Attendance update:






Unfortunately whole school attendance compared to last Monday has dropped to 91.1% and overall this year it is now 93.7%, which is a slight drop. Well done Y1 Mulberry for having the best class attendance last week of 97.7%! We are striving to be above 96% for whole school attendance, so please **only keep your children at home if they are really poorly.** Thank you for getting your children to school on time and ready to learn!

How Attendance is managed and reported at Willow Wood Community Nursery and Primary School

At Willow Wood Community Nursery and Primary School **ALL** children's attendance is monitored daily. When a child's attendance falls below 96 %, their attendance becomes a concern. Attendance will be reported to Parents every 4-6 weeks. For Parents of Children who are persistently late for school and/ or have a high number of unauthorised absences, they will receive additional communications and will be invited into School for Attendance meetings.




The screen will look like this:

Add your child's username (DO NOT leave any spaces in between unless the log in card shows this).




The screen will look like this:

This is the table of trips for this term. Again if 80% of the payments are not paid by the dates in the table, unfortunately the trip will have to be cancelled. This is mostly due to high coach costs, as school cannot afford to fund a half full bus. For example the entry tickets to Chester Zoo were free and the cost is for a workshop and the coach travel. When the trip goes ahead any children who have not paid will unfortunately not attend the trip and will stay in school on the day of the trip.

Free School Meals and Pupil Premium

Your child may be able to get free school meals/pupil premium if you are in receipt of any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

• Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

The criteria also apply if your child is adopted or under a special guardianship order. Please speak to the school office if you need any help with applying or have any questions. It is important that you register, even if your child currently receives Universal Free Infant School Meals as there is additional funding (Pupil Premium) that school can apply for https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals

Finally

Thank you to all the parents who are reading with their children at home at least 5 times a week, you are helping your child to expand their vocabulary and grasp of language, as well as introducing them to new words, phrases, and sentence structures. They will receive a raffle ticket every week they read 5 times and will be in with a chance to win a bike or a tablet at the end of term, so the more they read the more chances they have to win!

Please continue to read with you child at home everyday to support them on their learning journey.
