- I should be able to draw simple maps and recognise simple symbols.

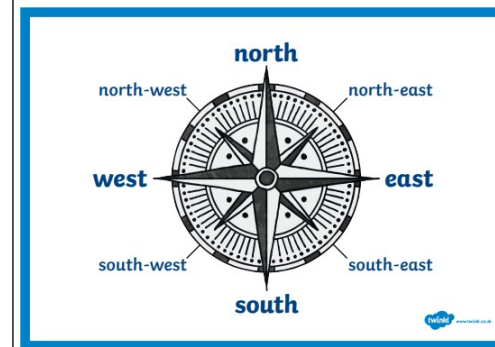
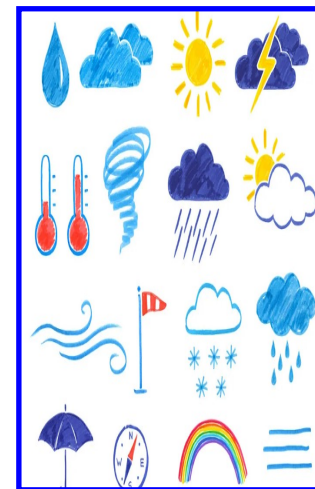
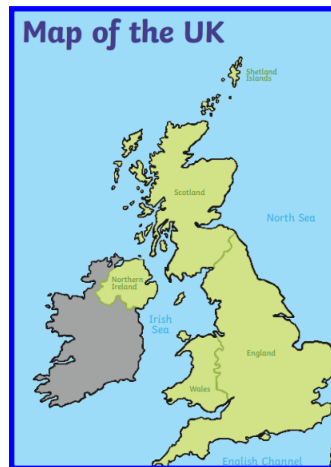
What I will learn (Sticky knowledge)

Change	When something is different.
Climate	the usual weather conditions in a place.
Cloud	A white or grey mass of fine drops of water or ice high in the earth's atmosphere.
Compass	An instrument for showing direction
Continent	One of the earth's seven major areas of land.
East	The right point on a compass.
Human Geography	The study of humans, place, people and environment.
North	The top direction on a compass.
Observe	To watch closely.
Physical Geography	The study of the earth.
Predict	To tell in advance that something will happen.
Satellite	A spacecraft that is sent into orbit
Seasons	One of the four parts of the year; spring, summer, autumn, and winter.
South	The bottom point of a compass, opposite North.
West	The left point of a compass.
Weather symbol	Pictures to show different types of weather.
Weather	The conditions outside at a particular place and time.
